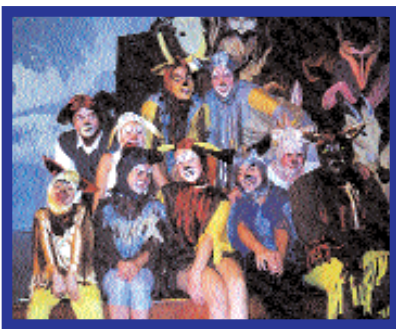

In the early part of the 19th century, the Quaker minister Edward Hicks had a dream. He envisioned the opportunity to work out a just peace in the conflict between the Native Americans and the European Americans as a chance to fulfill this biblical prophecy, bringing peace to the world. *A Peaceable Kingdom*, his landmark series of more than 100 paintings, was his sermon to that end.

In the 21st century the Conflict/Resolution Curriculum is taught from K-12, in our Universities and used as a model for high level negotiations around the globe. We still dream the same dream.

The Falloons found Hicks’ Outsider masterpiece of the lion laying down with the lamb an IDEAL setting for these themes. Kids will find, making pretend you are a lion OR a lamb is more fun than Play Station 2!

Now you can book “The Peaceable Kingdom Falloon Residency,” for the children in your educational outreach program. Your kids join the Grand Falloons, grantees of the NEA, Rockefeller Foundation and MacArthur awards for the exploration of collaboration between the fine arts and performing arts. Together, after a short residency, they perform this Falloon Fractured Fairytale in which these wild and domestic animals come to celebrate their differences, and treasure a world of peace.
